## New Building Permanent Exhibit - About 30 Minutes



The guide for the permanent exhibit introducing Ryoma's life and the end of the Edo period begins with an overview of Ryoma himself, followed by key events such as Perry's arrival, the Satsuma-Choshu Alliance, the Teradaya Incident, and the founding of the Kaientai, all presented in chronological order. Ryoma appears as the storyteller, sharing episodes about his family and his mentor, Katsu Kaishu. By listening to the audio guide alongside historical materials like letters, visitors can experience the rich and captivating story of Sakamoto Ryoma.



## Main Building 2F Exhibition Room - About 10 Minutes



The main building presents everyday life, customs, and the social system from the time when Ryoma lived. Enjoy displays inspired by the Iroha Maru, a restored model of the Omiya Inn, and a view of the Pacific Ocean from the rooftop. Audio guides are also available for a deeper experience.
